The Show

This is a prestigious event where hedge layers from all over the UK, come together to compete for the title “Supreme Champion”.

The event places great emphasis on education and the importance of hedge laying as part of an integrated approach to the maintenance and sustainability of our countryside. It includes a ‘hands on’ opportunity, craft demonstrations and trade stands. Exhibitors who have attended previously include, The Butterfly Conservation Trust, British Beekeepers’ Association, British Hedgehog Preservation Society and the Countryside Restoration Trust.

Refreshments will be available.

The location is The National Trust Stourhead Estate, near Mere, Wiltshire, BA12 6QF, easily accessible from the A303.

The entrance to the site is opposite the entrance to the **Stourhead Gardens**, famous for their wonderful display of autumnal colours and which will be very busy on the day of the Championship. This prominent location is expected to produce considerable footfall.

Traders may set up on Friday 27th October and must be open for trading by 9:00 am on Saturday 28th.
