## **CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY**

Competitors will be sent confirmation one week before the competition with relevant details of the venue if needed.

### Competition Rules:

1. To be eligible for judging, the work must be that of the named competitor only.
2. Each competitor's hedge must join the next section.
3. The **Hedge style** must conform to the following: Maximum Height of 4ft; maximum width of 3ft. Finished hedges in all styles must be stock-proof. (Binders will be provided if needed and should be placed as per style of hedge). Excessive use of dead material will be penalised.
4. **Chainsaws will not be allowed this year.** There will only be one class – Open.
5. The draw for stages will take place at 9.00am at "**Meeting Point**" (Furlongs farm, Ancrum TD8 6UY). The competition will start at 9.30am and finish at 3.00pm.
6. In all cases the decision of the judges will be final. Judging will be completed by 3.30pm, after which the prize giving will be held.
