CLASSES

- **Class 1 Open:** Open to any competitor who has previously won a first prize in any hedge laying competition – to the man who shall cut and lay 10 yards of hedge in the best manner in five hours.
- **Class 2 Novice:** Open to all except competitors who have previously won a first prize in a hedge laying competition – to the man who shall cut and lay 10 yards of hedge in the best manner in five hours. (If this is a first entry into a Hunt competition you can compete in pairs and cut 15 yards of hedge. Competitors need to compete as an individual to qualify for other events.)
- **Class 3 Veterans:** Open to any competitor aged 60 or over on the day of the competition– to the man who shall cut and lay 8 yards of hedge in the best manner in five hours.

- A prize for the best local competitor – residing in Belvoir country competing in any class
- £20 will be awarded to each competitor who satisfactorily finishes his length of hedge.

All competitors are invited to the prize giving in a nearby pub at the end of the competition. Tea will be served from 3 pm. Prize giving will be after the days hunting, around 4 pm.

RULES: The rules for the hedge laying competition are as follows:

1. Competitors to Cut, Lay, Stake and Bind 10 yards of hedge (8 yards for veterans) in 5 hours making a start and a finish and sharpen their own stakes in the best manner. All work to be completed by 2.30 pm when a warning will be sounded.
2. 20 stakes for each competitor
3. The first two layers to be laid one on either side for the first competitor to finish.
4. All the brush to be put away as per the Stewards instructions.
5. Competitors to be at the field for the draw at **9:00 am and start plashing at 9:30 am**
6. Assistance only at Steward's discretion
7. No dead wood to be left in the hedge
