- 2 Crooks may be used, no stakes nor bonds please.
- 3 The height will be stated on the day.
- Any competitor failing to complete the fence must complete it after the allotted time.
- Chainsaw Protocol: Proper personal protective equipment must be worn when operating the saw. Do not wear loose-fitting clothing. Be careful that the trunk or tree limbs will not bind against the saw. Watch for branches under tension; they may spring out when cut.
